Conditions of Entry

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions

1. Event is conducted under PCV rules - NO STALLIONS, COLTS OR RIGS PERMITTED - This includes EA combinations
2. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and your acceptance of these rules.
3. EA Classes to be run in accordance with EA National Eventing Rules (current edition)
4. Pony Club classes to be run in accordance with PCV rules for Horse Trials
5. There shall be no refunds after the closing date unless the event secretary is notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or medical doctor's certificate is provided within 7 days of notification. All refunds will incur a \$15 administration fee.
6. PCV Code of Conduct applies to all entrants. PCV Responsible Alcohol Policy applies.
7. The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times and refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.
8. Current PCV grading cards required all PCV classes
9. Riders must have current EA membership for all EA classes.
10. Horses must be registered with current Eventing licence for EA classes EvA95 & above
11. EA or HRCV membership for EvA65 or EvA50 class.
12. EvA65 and EvA50 class run under EvVic rules for low level events 2016
13. Supplying a volunteer is a condition of entry. All riders must sign up for a job via the Sign Up Link. Riders who do not sign up will be assigned a job.
14. No lunging is allowed at this event.
15. PCV Gear Check: required for PCV riders before each phase. PCA gear rules apply.
16. EA Gear Check: None Riders onus applies
17. All riders, volunteers and spectators must adhere to all Victorian government COVID-19 policies and restrictions at the time of the event.
18. Dogs must be on leads and under control at all times.
19. Competitor numbers – All riders must provide their own back numbers and holders. Competitors may supply their own numbers on bridle or saddlecloth on either side of the horse for dressage and show jumping.
20. Body numbers must be used for cross-country.
21. In the event that the competition is cancelled due to circumstances outside the club's control, the committee reserves the right to charge a \$15 administration fee on the refund of entry fees.
22. It is the responsibility of riders to collect ribbons, rugs and prizes at the venue. These will not be posted.
23. XC Optimum Time Trophies will be awarded in the same manner as PC Ride to Time. i.e., to the rider who achieves a clear round with no jump penalties, and who rides to exact optimum time or closest to the time (either under or over). One trophy per PCV grade.
